

How-to instructions for seed packets.

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Steps **MUST** be followed in exact order. Items needed: scissors, glue stick, crayons, colored pencils or markers. Colors and labels on this page are for instruction purposes only. Actual seed packets will be marked as printed from website. Glue this side of tab

Glue other side of this tab

- 1—Cut out the seed packet along exterior outline (shown in red).
- 2—Fold narrow tab (marked in blue) along yellow line so that “glue this side” is facing up and out.
- 3—Fold packet in half along green center line.
- 4—Run glue stick along narrow tab (marked blue) and press “Notes” flap down onto it for an even seal.
- 5—Fold bottom tab (marked pink) upward along yellow line so that it closes bottom. “Glue other side” will be facing up and out. Apply glue to interior side of tab, sealing packet closed. You might want to fold bottom tab first and form a strong crease before running glue stick across the “inside” of tab.
- 6—Fold top flap along yellow line and form crease. Your packet is now formed and ready for seeds.
- 7—Color your packet!
- 8—When you are ready to store and save your seeds for your next planting, complete information on outside (type, variety, date, etc.) then fill packet with seeds. Glue top flap closed for secure storage.
